Program Overview

At Manchester University, earning an accounting degree means you will be the sort of tax or audit professional that accounting firms value and every business needs. A bachelor's degree in accounting from Manchester, in other words, opens a world of opportunities, whether in major corporations or small businesses. This 3+1 program enables students to earn a bachelor's and master's degree in four years, eliminating a year of increased costs and lost earnings. In addition, because MU offers an MBA with an Accounting Track students will be full-time undergraduate students and they will retain all their undergraduate financial aid—making Manchester's MBA much more affordable than other programs.
